(Typically takes 6 semesters, but 5 possible with aggressive scheduling.)	Have Advisory Committee appointed before first recital. Spring				Pre-exam appointment with Director of Graduate Studies, preferably early in final semester of coursework. Oral Exam Repertoire List (submit to Advisory Committee chair and ask chair to forward, with approval, to Music Graduate Office). Minor and major field written qualifying exam(s). You may take a written qualifying exam if: [1] proficiencies and tool subjects are complete, [2] courses in the field to be examined are complete, and [3] in or after last semester of classes overall. First exam must be taken within 7 years of matriculation. Oral qualifying exam (must be passed within one year of date first written exam is passed)	Spring	
Year 4 Fall			Complete any remaining recitals.		Write prose component of Final Project. Submit to Music Graduate Office with Research Director approval. Research Committee review (up to 6 weeks). Apply for graduation. Schedule Public Presentation (oral exam must be passed first). Pass Public Presentation.	Year 4 Fall
