## Bachelor of Music, Piano

**Major Ensemble** (2 cr.) required every fall and spring semester in which student is registered. X 70 University Choral Ensembles, X 40 Instrumental Ensembles or X 60 Early Music Ensembles required during the first 4 semesters of enrollment (before Upper Division exam). X 2 Piano Accompanying required each semester after Upper Division exam.

**Performance Study** P400 Piano Undergraduate Major. 6 credit hours each semester until senior recital is passed. Entrance audition, freshman jury, upper division examination, junior recital, senior recital. I300 Studio Masterclass and/or I301 Departmental Masterclass may be required in connection with performance study (varies by studio).

**Keyboard Proficiency** must be completed within the department prior to upper division exam.

T351, M401, M402 and Advanced Lit/Theory courses may be taken in any order after the completion of MUS-T252.

**Advanced Music Literature and Music Theory** 3 credit hours selected from M410 Composer or Genre (3 cr.), T410 Topics in Music Theory (3 cr.), T412 Advanced Aural and Keyboard Techniques (3 cr.), T416 Counterpoint (3 cr.), T417 Analysis of Tonal Music (3 cr.), T418 Music and Ideas (3 cr.) or E410 Topics in Music Education (3 cr.).

## **Other Music Courses** 12 credit hours:

Required: E493 Piano Pedagogy (2 cr.)

F300 Piano Accompanying (1-1-1-1 cr.) required during first 4 semesters of enrollment.

*Electives*: 6 credits to be chosen from undergraduate courses for music majors.
