CINCINNATI SYMPHONY-PRINCIPAL HORN



Elizabeth Freimuth is the principal horn of the Cincinnati Symphony and Pops Orchestras. Before joining the CSO in 2006, Freimuth was principal horn of the San Francisco Ballet Orchestra (2005-2006), principal horn of the Kansas City Symphony (2000-2005) and assistant principal horn of the Colorado Symphony (1998-2000).

Freimuth has performed as the featured soloist with the Cincinnati Symphony, Kansas City Symphony, Overland Park Symphony (KS) and the Lakewood Symphony (CO).

In 2011, Freimuth joined the Adjunct Horn faculty at CCM. From 2000-2003, she was the Adjunct Professor of Horn at the University of Missouri in Kansas City Conservatory of Music.

Freimuth is a graduate and recipient of the coveted Performer's Certificate of the Eastman School of Music (B.M.) and a graduate of Rice University Shepherd School of Music (M.M.) where she studied horn with Verne Reynolds, W.Peter Kurau and William VerMeulen respectively.
