Prior to winning the audition for ISO Principal Horn, Rob was principal for the Grand Rapids Symphony Orchestra. He has held co-principal or associate principal positions with the Toledo and Omaha Symphony Orchestras, and the Cincinnati Chamber Orchestra. He has been a fellow at the Tanglewood Music Center and a member of the Civic Orchestra of Chicago, the training orchestra of the Chicago Symphony Orchestra. ISO audience members may remember his first being in the spotlight when he was prominently featured as our “sub” principal during the Shostakovich First Cello Concerto with Antonio Meneses soloing and Jiri Belohlavek on the podium. Rob is adjunct associate professor of Music at DePauw University in Greencastle, Indiana. He has been a performer and lecturer at the 2003 and 2009 International Horn Symposiums. His horn is a Conn Schmidt Model made in the 1930s.
