Thomas Jöstlein is the associate Principal Horn of the St. Louis Symphony Orchestra since 2010. Formerly assistant Principal Horn of the New York Philharmonic, he has performed as guest Principal with the Philadelphia and Orpheus Chamber Orchestras.

An enthusiast for classical natural horn playing, he performs on both a Seraphinoff Halari copy and a Lucien-Joseph Raoux from 1820. On the Seraphinoff, he has played the Haydn Concerto in D, and the Brahms Trio with original instruments, including with pianist Brian Connelly and violinist Stephanie Chase on his Raoux.

He is also a published composer of music for alphorn, horn ensembles, and woodwinds, and has taught at many universities, including the University of Illinois and as a guest at Indiana University.

He is indebted to his teachers, hornist William VerMeulen and tubists Arnold Jacobs and Roger Rocco, and loves sharing their message of liberation from the instrument.
