6:00-6:40pm English Horn Auditions

Repertoire:

1. A 440 presentation (as if in the orchestra)
2. Two contrasting movements from a concerto or solo oboe work of the student's choice
3. Oboe orchestral excerpts will be chosen from the following works:
 - Beethoven – Symphony No. 7
 - Brahms – Violin Concerto
 - Strauss – Don Juan
 - Rimsky-Korsakov – Scheherazade
4. English horn excerpts will be chosen from the following works:
 - Dvorak – New World
 - Rossini – William Tell
 - Debussy – Nocturnes

Note: Students are expected to prepare the entire parts of the works listed above. Any portion of the works could be requested by the committee (including tutti sections).

Although audition on English horn is at the student's option, all students are expected to plan an oboe audition.

Procedure: All auditions will be approximately 10 minutes in length. A sign-up sheet with audition times will be posted on the Oboe Bulletin Board (MU 102) beginning Thursday, August 26.

- Sign up for your chosen time by 5:00pm, Sunday, August 29.
- Fill out the beginning of the year Student Assessment/Planning Packet which will be e-mailed to you before the auditions.
 - Note:* Fill this out according to guidelines and bring two copies to your audition on Monday. Keep another copy for your reference. Teachers will review the materials for your first lesson later in the week.
- Ensemble placement results will be posted on the Ensemble Board. Once notified, make schedule arrangements accordingly.
